ALLEN TATE RANKS FIRST IN THE CAROLINAS, FOURTH IN THE COUNTRY

For the past 31 years, Allen Tate Companies has captured the top spot on the list of residential real estate firms based in the Carolinas. In Charlotte, a group of real estate volunteers will be painting and landscaping at two transitional living houses at the Harvest Center of Charlotte. Other home sites from Mint Hill to Mooresville will also get needed repairs.

The public is invited to drop off nonperishable items at the Charlotte Regional Realtor Association office at 1201 Greenwood Cliff.
