
Minimum system requirements for TEMPO™ 5

- Microsoft Windows 7, Vista, or Microsoft XP operating system with Service Pack 2 or higher.
- TEMPO 5 is now available on your Mac! CMLS has arranged to offer its members IDS, an application you can run on your Apple computer that will give you full access to TEMPO 5. Contact the CMLS Help Desk for more information.
- Internet Explorer 6.0 with Service Pack 2 or higher.
- Internet access with a 56 kbps connection speed (higher-speed cable modem, DSL or faster is recommended).
- 1.8 GHz Intel Pentium 4 (or equivalent); recommended: 2.8 GHz, Intel Pentium.
- 512 MB RAM (recommended 1 GB RAM).
- 1024 x 768 resolution
- The ability to download and install ActiveX components (see “Installing ActiveX Controls for TEMPO 5” at the end of this document).

Set up your privacy/pop-up blocker for TEMPO 5

Pop-up blockers must be set up to accept/allow pop ups from tempo.carolinamls.com. This can be done from any pop-up blocker in the accepted/allowed sites area. Internet Explorer has a pop-up blocker; to allow pop-up blockers for our website, please follow these steps:

- From Internet Explorer, select “Tools” and “Internet Options.”
- Select the Privacy Tab.
- In the Pop-up Blocker section, if you have a check mark next to “Turn on Pop-up Blocker,” click on “Settings.” If that selection is unchecked, you can click “OK.”
- If you clicked on “Settings,” type in tempo.carolinamls.com and click “Add.”



Other pop-up blocker programs are similar. If you do not know how to add an accepted/allowed site to your pop-up blocker, you will need to consult your pop-up blocker software vendor.

Set up your security for TEMPO 5

The TEMPO 5 URL/website must be added to the trusted sites list in Internet options. Follow these steps:


- From Internet Explorer, select “Tools” and “Internet Options.”
- Select the Security Tab.
- Select “Trusted sites.”
- Select “Sites” and add tempo.carolinamls.com to the list.



Set up advanced options for TEMPO 5

The Internet Explorer Advanced tab option, “Empty Temporary Internet Folder when browser is closed,” must be unchecked. This will enable the TEMPO 5 system files to be cached (saved) for faster access. Follow these steps:


- From Internet Explorer, select “Tools” and “Internet Options.”
- Select the Advanced Tab and scroll to the security section.
- Uncheck the option “Empty temporary Internet Files Folder when browser is closed.”
- Click “Apply,” “OK,” and then close and restart the browser.



Installing ActiveX controls for TEMPO 5

ActiveX Controls are required to use all functions of TEMPO 5. Once you are logged into the system, complete the following to install the ActiveX system components:

- Click on “My Sidebar” (in TEMPO 5). This will take you to the MLS links. At the very top, you will see the “TEMPO™ 5 Documentation” header.
- Click on “TEMPO™ 5 ActiveX Controls” just below the header. This will open the window as shown below.
- Click “Install.”
- A series of different windows will appear to install each system component. ActiveX files need only be installed once and require you to agree to the install when prompted. These will need to be installed on each PC that accesses TEMPO 5.



More information on ActiveX controls

ActiveX controls are small programs, sometimes also called add-ons, that are used to enhance your browsing experience by allowing animation, or they can help with tasks such as installing security updates.

Some websites require you to install ActiveX controls to see the site or perform certain tasks. TEMPO 5 uses ActiveX controls to deliver convenient and necessary additional functionality such as printing reports and viewing of listing images. ActiveX controls can only be installed if you are logged in as the administrator of the PC you are on (in most cases, when you log into your home PC you are more than likely logged in as the administrator).
