<u>Withdrawal / Transfer Policy</u>

Written notice is required for all withdrawals and transfers.

Withdrawal/Transfer <u>Prior</u> to class starting: If a student wishes to withdraw <u>prior to the start of class</u>, he or she may transfer to another class with full tuition credit **only twice within six months**, or receive a refund less \$50 administrative services fee.
