



Realtor® of the Year Award

Individuals must be nominated by a member of the selection committee or by another active member of the association, and will be submitted on an official Realtor® of the Year form developed and approved by the committee, or by personal letter, but in no case will petitions be accepted or considered by the committee.

Consideration should be given to contributions and activities based on the following: faithfulness to Code of Ethics and North Carolina laws and regulations; efforts made to encourage good real estate practices among other agents; participation in civic and service clubs; charitable activities; political action, task forces, educational work.

The recipient will be honored at the Charlotte Regional Realtor® Association/Carolina Multiple Listing Services Holiday Awards Luncheon and Annual Meeting.

Criteria

- The nominee must be a member of the Charlotte Regional Realtor® Association.
- The nominee must have made outstanding contributions to the community above and beyond his/her activities in the real estate profession.
- Activities must include involvement in civic, church, state and/or political arenas.
- The nominee must exemplify outstanding loyalty and dedication to the success of the association through association volunteer work.
- The nominee must have been involved in some way with the local association. Local association involvement may include service on a committee, task force, or similar activity. Attendance at any of the association sponsored functions, ie., Holiday Luncheon, Realtor® Expo, Realtor® Hot Topics, Fish Fry, etc., is a plus, but not required.
- The nominee must demonstrate superior service to clients, cooperation with regard to other members of the association and multiple listing services, if applicable.
- Helpful but not required: The nominee holds professional designations and is involved in some way with the state and/or national association of Realtors®.
