

## Where Your Money Goes and What Your Donation Makes Possible

**Community Grants:** Since 2009,\$603,299 has been awarded to address unmet housing needs in Mecklenburg, Iredell and Haywood counties.

**Habitat for Humanity:** Since 2007, the Foundation has awarded \$374,000 to regional Habitat organizations to assist them in building affordable homes.

**Humanitarian Award**: Since 2007, the foundation has awarded \$56,520 to 17 award recipients designated to their non-profit of choice in their name.

**Project R.E.A.C.H.:** Project R.E.A.C.H. (Realtors® Engaging And Creating Hope) sends 125 Realtor® Volunteers annually to serve at five pre-selected nonprofits, who have received \$16,250 in direct support.

**Realtors**® **Care Day:** 347 families and nonprofit organizations have received assistance with exterior home repair projects with a total economic impact of more than \$1.2 million.

**Strides for Shelter 5K & Fun Run:** In the race's eight-year history, more than \$212,000 has been distributed to assist local homeless initiatives.

**Youth Excellence in Service (YES) Award:** This award is presented annually to area youth who are engaged in improving the quality of life in the region. \$3,500 has been donated on behalf of the recipients since 2019.
